We hope you will be encouraged as we share Jason's testimony with you this month:


I have been going to church with my family for my entire life. My mother was very involved in our home church and my brother graduated from a Christian college to become a pastor. I grew up just assuming I was saved because I knew about Jesus and went to church all the time. In high school my desire for acceptance led me to do things I knew were wrong. I conformed to most of the immoral subjects that my friends were talking and joking about even though I refused to take part in any partying or any drugs or alcohol. I was even known as “the Christian kid.” At no point during this time did it ever occur to me that I might not be saved.

Within the first week of getting to college I met a campus minister at Cornerstone Christian Church by taking his survey. I agreed to come to church and do a Bible study with him. Every time I met for the Bible study I could feel a literal discomfort within myself but I didn't know what was wrong. I met for the Bible study and went to church for over 7 months during my freshman year when finally God revealed Titus 1:16 to me, which says, “They profess to know God, but by their deeds they deny Him...” God revealed to me that I was pro-

fessing His name but I had never repented and that the way I was living my life was denying Him. I realized then that the discomfort I had felt all this time was the Lord working on my heart and preparing me to surrender my entire life to Him.

On April 5th, 2011 I met up with the campus minister and told him about what the Lord has been showing me. On that day I surrendered my

life to Jesus! Since then, God has been faithful at cleaning up my life and sanctifying me just as His word promises. I am very thankful that my old life has been done away with and for the new life that the Lord has provided me with in His church.
